Subject: bibag® Disposable Installation Update

1.0 PURPOSE

To provide an update to the installation of a bi $bag^{@}$ disposable onto the bi $bag^{@}$ connector on bi $bag^{@}$ equipped 2008K@Home[™] Hemodialysis Machines.

2.0 SCOPE

As part of continuous improvement, the 2008K@Home[™] User Guide (P/N 490180) is being updated to provide clarity and capture accurate intent of how to connect a bi*b*ag[®] disposable to the bi*b*ag[®] connector nozzles. The change applies to step (c) of the note listed below:



Note: If the bibag disposable is the bicarbonate source, do not pull the blue bicarbonate connector from the machine's rinse port. Do the following to prepare the bibag disposable:

- Remove the plastic seal from underneath the water and bicarbonate nozzles of the bibag disposable.
- b) Open the bibag door on the machine by lifting up on the dark-gray handle.
- with the white bibag handle facing outward, hang the bag on the bibag connector
 nozzles.
- Close the door, making sure it latches firmly in place. An audible click means the door is closed.

With the white bibag® handle facing outward, hang bibag® disposable on the bibag® connector nozzles. Push down where indicated in the figure below (red arrows) until it is fully seated onto the bibag® connector nozzles.

Once the $bibag^{\otimes}$ disposable is fully seated, close $bibag^{\otimes}$ door until it latches into place (an audible click is heard when door is closed)
