


Option 2: You can choose to receive an on-screen alert without an audible alarm.




Option 3: You can choose to turn both Flow Alert notifications OFF.




### Removal of the Scale



Choose your heater bag volume during initial setup.




Once selected, your choice becomes the default setting for your future treatments. You won't have to change it again unless your bag volume changes.




If needed, press **Back** to change your heater bag volume.





If the "personal data" option is set to YES, the Personal Health Data screen will appear after a completed treatment. Value boxes are blank at first and can be changed by touching an individual box and using the Up/Down arrows.

# Add Diurnal UF Setting is Now Set to YES



The add diurnal UF setting is now set to YES. This means that the ultrafiltration (UF) from Drain O is now included in the total UF.
